4 Weeks Out: Audit & Logistics

Perform the 'Cost Per Pound' Audit:

- Assess your inventory. If you are moving to a warmer state like Arizona or Florida, sell or donate heavy winter gear (like snowblowers) to reduce weight and volume costs.

Pro Tip: Decluttering now reduces the estimated hourly labor for local moves later.

Map the 'Last Mile' Access:

- Review your current and new addresses for large truck accessibility.
- Identify tight turns or cul-de-sacs, especially if you are in Olde Town Arvada or Meadowlake.
- Notify your moving coordinator about these details immediately.

2 Weeks Out: The 'Interstate Standard' Pack

Adopt the Interstate Mindset:

- Even if moving intrastate (locally), pack boxes as if they are traveling cross-country.
- Use proper padding and filling; short trips can still cause damage if items shift.

Prepare Wood Furniture for Climate Change:

- If staying in Arvada/Denver, ensure wood is conditioned for the dry, high altitude.
- If moving to a humid state (e.g., Texas, Tennessee), prepare antiques and pianos for moisture acclimation to prevent warping.

Moving Day: The Essentials

Pack Your 'First Night' Kit:

- Set aside luggage or a clear plastic bin that stays with you, not on the truck.
- Must-haves: Phone chargers, toiletries, medications, and a change of clothes.



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Final Walkthrough
